

ANNOUNCEMENTS

- **SWIM QUALIFICATIONS**: We will begin the Saturday drill at the Roy Recreation Center (in the Roy High School parking lot) to obtain swim qualifications for all cadets. <u>Muster in swim gear</u>, but be sure to bring your complete Type III uniform to change into when the qualifications are completed. The NSCC qualification guidance and qualification form are attached so you can see exactly what you will need to do. There are some links to Navy videos for help included in the guidance instructions. Unit officers will ensure that the cadets are moved to UMA when the qualifications are completed.
- **CHIEF PINNING**: On Sunday afternoon, we will be formally promoting Cadet M. Otinel to the rank of Chief Petty Officer. The ceremony will begin at 2pm and a cake will be provided. <u>Dismissal will occur after the ceremony, so all cadet families are encouraged to attend at 2pm</u>.

THIS MONTH IN U.S. AND NAVY HISTORY

2 May 2011President Barack Obama announces Navy SEALs raided Osama bin Laden's compound in Abbottabad, Pakistan, and
killed America's most wanted terrorist.
5 May 1961Navy CDR Alan Shepard Jr. makes the first U.S. manned space flight.
8 May 1945The unconditional surrender of Germany to end their participation in WWII was ratified by Allies in Berlin. This event
is remembered as V-E Day!
22 May 1968 USS Scorpion (SSN 589) is lost with her crew south-west of the Azores. In late October 1968, her remains are found
on the sea floor more than 10,000 feet below the surface.

27 May 1942Mess Attendant 2nd Class Doris Miller receives the Navy Cross for his heroism at Pearl Harbor, Dec. 7, 1941. ADM Chester W. Nimitz presents the medal to Miller on board *USS Enterprise (CV 6)*. He is killed when his ship is torpedoed Nov. 24, 1943, during the invasion of the Gilbert Islands.

28 May 198055 women become the first female graduates of the U.S. Naval Academy.
